Invitation to Tender:

The Town of Carberry and the Municipality of North Cypress-Langford are seeking quotations from qualified weed control contractors to provide weed management services on an on-call, as-needed basis throughout the spring, summer, and fall seasons.

Services will be required at jointly managed properties within the town of Carberry, including but not limited to:

- Parks and playgrounds (CP Park, 125 Park)
- CNCL Ball park
- CNCL Campground
- Carberry Plains Community Centre (CPCC)
- CNCL Fire Hall
- Museum and Gingerbread House
- CNCL Library
- 122 Main Street and adjacent park
- Drop-In Centre
- Carberry Community Memorial Hall
- Carberry Plains Cemetery
- CNCL Transfer Station

Additional properties may be added as required.



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Contractor Requirements:

The successful contractor must:

- Hold all certifications and licences required under Manitoba legislation for herbicide/pesticide application.
- Provide proof of valid Manitoba Pesticide Applicator License in the appropriate category for municipal weed control services.
- Maintain valid liability, chemical misuse and spray drift insurance and WCB coverage.
- Maintain application records for every pesticide application required by Manitoba legislation.
- Supply all equipment, vehicles, chemicals, personal protective equipment, and materials necessary to perform the work.
- Comply with all applicable provincial and federal regulations.
- Provide services in a safe and professional manner.

Scope of Work:

Services will include:

- Spot spraying and weed control treatments.
- Control of noxious and nuisance weeds.
- Treatment around buildings, fence lines, parking lots, pathways, signs, and other municipal infrastructure.
- Follow-up treatments as required.

Work will be requested by municipal staff and scheduled as needed throughout the season.

Pricing:

Please provide a fully inclusive hourly rate for weed control services.

The hourly rate must include:

- Labour
- Benefits and payroll costs
- Herbicides and chemicals
- Equipment and vehicle use



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- Fuel and travel within Carberry
- Personal protective equipment
- Administration and overhead
- Any other costs required to complete the work

No additional charges will be accepted unless approved in advance by the municipalities.
