

TOWN OF CARBERRY

BY-LAW No. 7/2003

A by-law to regulate the use of firearms.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Carberry may pass a by-law for municipal purposes respecting the following matters:

- 232(1) (a) the safety, health, protection and well-being of people, and the safety and protection of property;
(j) the sale and use of firecrackers and other fireworks, the use of rifles, guns and other firearms, and the use of bows and arrows and other devices.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carberry, in Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. THAT subject to Sections 2 and 3 hereof, no person shall fire a rifle, gun, revolver, pistol, or other firearm within the boundaries of the Town of Carberry
2. THAT Section 1 shall not apply to firing ranges and gun clubs approved by the Council of the Town of Carberry.
3. THAT Section 1 shall not apply to individuals appointed by resolution of Council and approved by the RCMP to deal with pest control problems within the boundaries of the Town of Carberry.
4. THAT subject to Section 5, no person shall use a catapult, sling, bow and arrow and other weapon within the boundaries of the Town of Carberry.
5. THAT Section 4 shall not apply to archery clubs approved by the Council of the Town of Carberry.
6. THAT no person shall fire or set off fireballs, squibs, firecrackers or other fireworks within the boundaries of the Town of Carberry, except with the prior written permission of the Council of the Town of Carberry.
7. THAT any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding \$500.00 in addition to costs, and in case of non-payment of fine and costs, to be imprisoned for a period not exceeding 30 days.
