

TOWN OF CARBERRY

BY-LAW NO. 3/2002

BEING A BY-LAW of the Town of Carberry to provide for the visible display of property addresses for houses along the streets, roads, and lanes of the Town of Carberry;

WHEREAS the Municipal Act section 232(1)(a) authorizes a Council to pass by-laws for purposes respecting the safety, health, protection and well-being of people, and the safety and protection of people and property;

AND WHEREAS in the opinion of the Council of the Town of Carberry it is deemed necessary and expedient to require visible display of property addresses for the safety and protection of people and property;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carberry, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the owner of each lot on which there is a building, house, or structure along a street, road, or lane in the Town of Carberry shall affix and maintain in legible condition a number or numbers as designated by the Town of Carberry to the front of each building, house, or structure fronting on a street.
2. Such numbers shall be:
 - (a) affixed in conspicuous places visible from the street, road, or lane during the day and night;
 - (b) no less than 10 cm (4 inches) in height;
 - (c) of contrasting colour to the building, house, or structure to which it is affixed; and
 - (d) durable to withstand all weather conditions.
3. Any owner of a lot on which there is a building, house, or structure requiring a number as aforesaid shall provide the same at his/her own expense and in the event of the failure to do so, the Town may erect such number or numbers at the expense of the owner.
4. The Town shall make and keep a record of the streets and numbers of the buildings, houses, or structures and it shall be the duty of the Town to assign a number as aforesaid to each building, house, or structure.
5. No person shall injure, deface, pull down, or destroy any such number.
6.
 - (a) Any person who commits an infraction of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of a summary offence and liable to an instant justice fine of \$50.00.
 - (b) The Town of Carberry may issue a warning for which no prosecution will be carried out and no fine shall be levied, if the person has not previously been charged with an offence pursuant to this by-law.
7.
 - (a) Any person who contravenes or disobeys, or refuses or neglects to obey any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable, on summary conviction, to a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$1000.00 for each day's neglect or failure to comply therewith and in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days.
 - (b) Any person who hinders or obstructs the Town of Carberry or any other representative of the Town under this by-law in the exercise of his duty is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$200.00, and in default of payment of the fine, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding fourteen (14) days.
8. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day following its passage.
