Preamble:

To determine who is responsible for the cost of sewer repairs or installations requiring excavation for lines leading to properties owned by rate payers.

Policy:

1. All repairs and or installations requiring excavation to sewer lines located in the Town of Carberry shall be under the direct supervision of the Town regardless if contracted publicly or privately. Line must be inspected by the Town of Carberry Public Works before being covered up.
2. The Town will be financially responsible for any and all repairs to that portion of sewer line leading from the main line to the property line of the ratepayer once it's in place. With the exception if the ratepayer is installing a new line to which the Town's infrastructure, ie. pavement, may be damaged or removed, then permission must be granted by the Town of Carberry and an agreement reached in writing with all parties.
3. The ratepayer will be financially responsible for any and all repairs to that portion of sewer line up to the connection with the Town's infrastructure at the property line.
4. The Town of Carberry will be responsible for the homeowner's repair/inspection invoice IF this has been approved by Council, the Town of Carberry Foreman or Acting Foreman. The Town of Carberry will only cover one invoice per household for each incident, for the cost of the initial inspection IF and only IF, the issue is the responsibility of the Town of Carberry.
