e. Millennium EMS Solutions Ltd – Request to Close and Bore 4th Ave

Res \$244-26 WHEREAS Millennium EMS Solutions Ltd. (MEMS), on behalf of Imperial Oil, has requested permission to access Town-owned property north of 629 4th Avenue for the purpose of conducting environmental site assessment work, including borehole drilling and the installation of groundwater monitoring wells; and

WHEREAS MEMS has requested lane closure on Fourth Ave during the periods of September 22 to 26, 2026 and October 20 to 22, 2026, with traffic control measures to be provided by the applicant;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council approves the request from MEMS for a partial lane closure on 4th Avenue and access to Town-owned property for the purposes of conducting borehole drilling and groundwater monitoring well installation, subject to the following conditions:

1. All required traffic control measures, signage, and public safety protections shall be installed and maintained by the applicant in accordance with applicable regulations and standards.
2. The applicant shall notify the Town prior to commencement of work.
3. Final borehole and monitoring well locations shall be reviewed with and approved by the Town prior to drilling and installation.
4. The applicant shall be responsible for any damage caused to municipal infrastructure as a result of the work.

5. Any damaged pavement, curb, boulevard, walking paths, trails, or other municipal property affected by the work shall be restored by the applicant to the satisfaction of the Town of Carberry at no cost to the Town.
6. The applicant shall repair any settlement, deterioration, or defects that may arise from the work for a period of one (1) year following completion of the restoration.
7. All costs associated with the work and restoration shall be the responsibility of the applicant.
